As part of a series of activities to involve people in shaping the future of the South Downs National Park, the South Downs National Park Authority is organising a series of Autumn Workshops.

These will be interactive workshops and they will build upon what we have been told by stakeholders so far. They will explore the key issues facing the South Downs that need to be addressed in the two documents that will guide the development of the South Downs National Park over the next 20 years - the South Downs National Park Management Plan and the Local Development Framework.

There will be a series of three workshops in each of the three constituent counties of the National Park; Hampshire, West Sussex and East Sussex. Ideally, you would attend all three workshops in your county. However, the number of delegates is limited to 70 at each venue, so we would ask you to let us know as soon as possible which you would like to attend.
