



Executive summary of Wealden analysis Summer results

This analysis is the result of a survey conducted in September 2011. The electronic survey was sent to all community contacts in Wealden. Community contacts are members of the public that have come into contact with local officers and been added to the database requesting regular police updates. They were asked 6 questions to determine what they percept to be a priority in their area. The priorities are listed below and ranged from truancy to car crime. The contacts were also asked about high visibility patrolling. The results can be seen below.

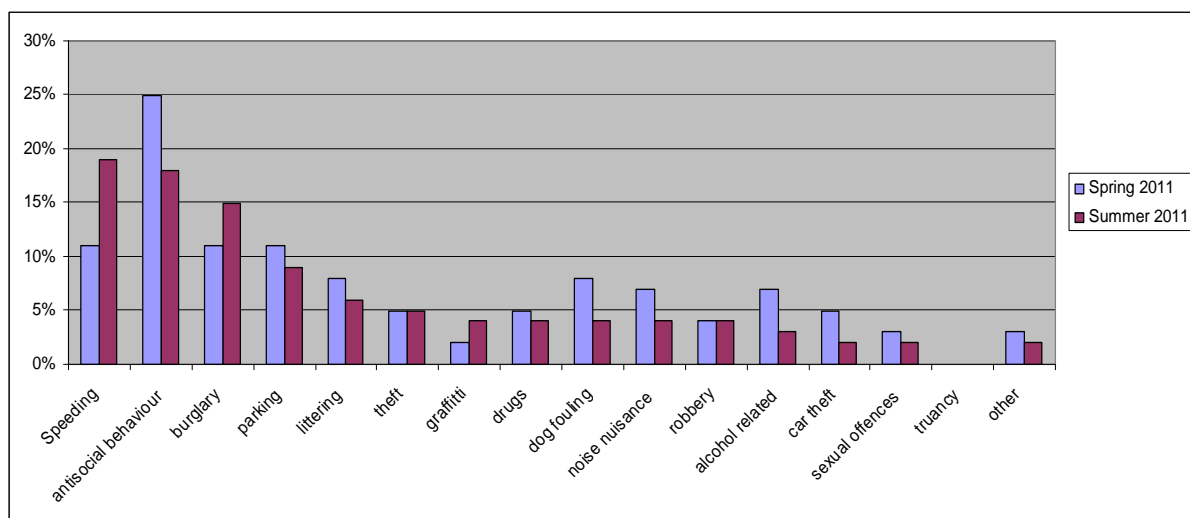

Comparison from results of spring 2011 survey



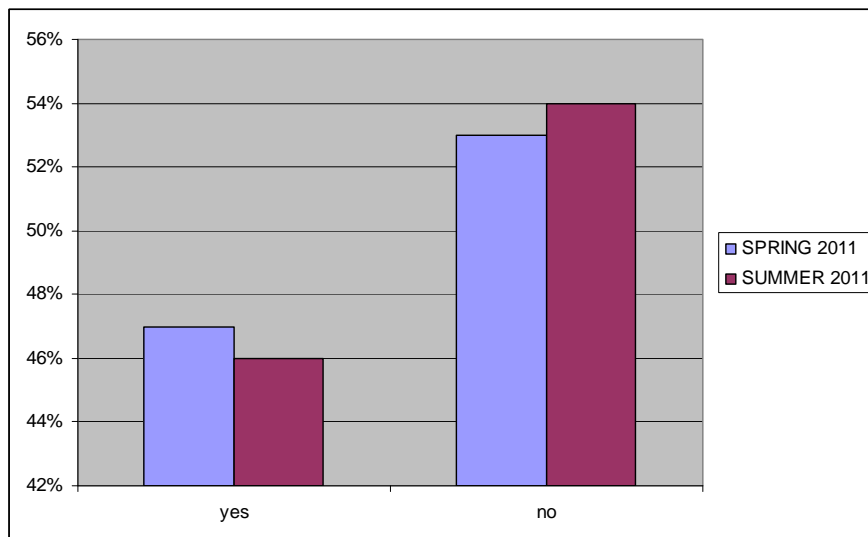

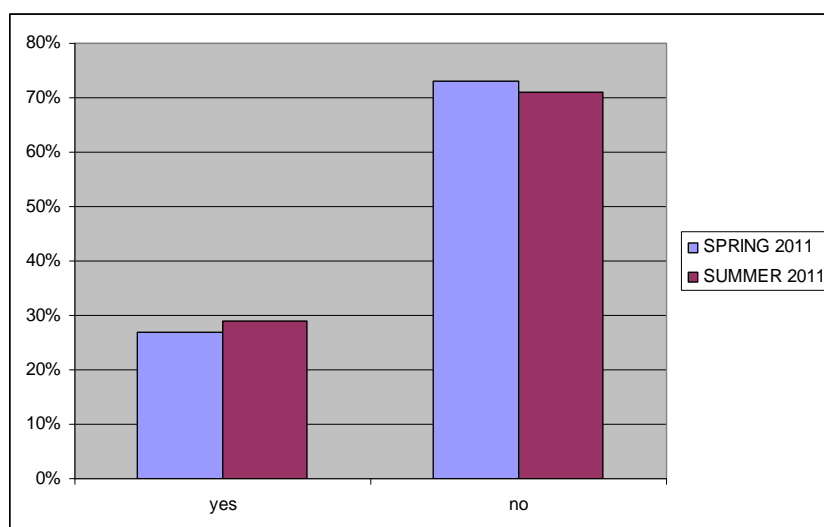

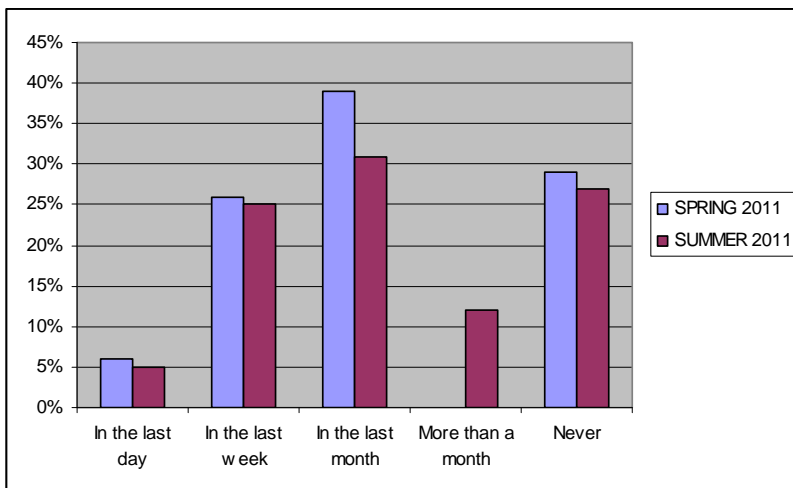

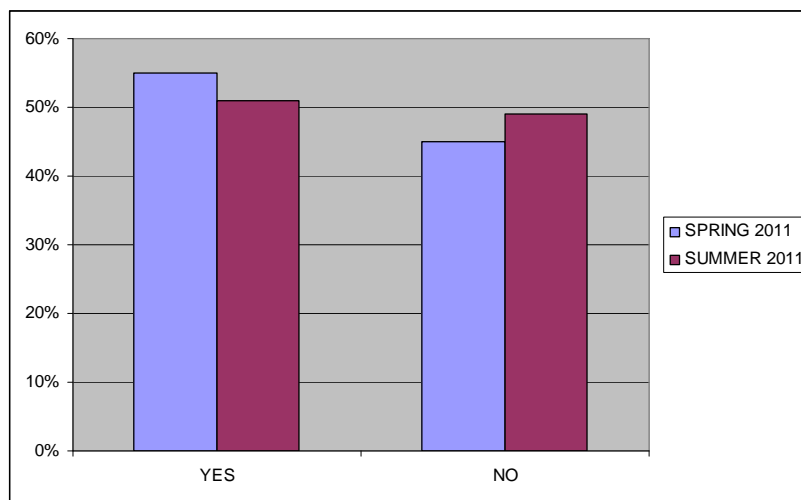
